Broadband Time Prices Fall 85.9 Percent Since 2015

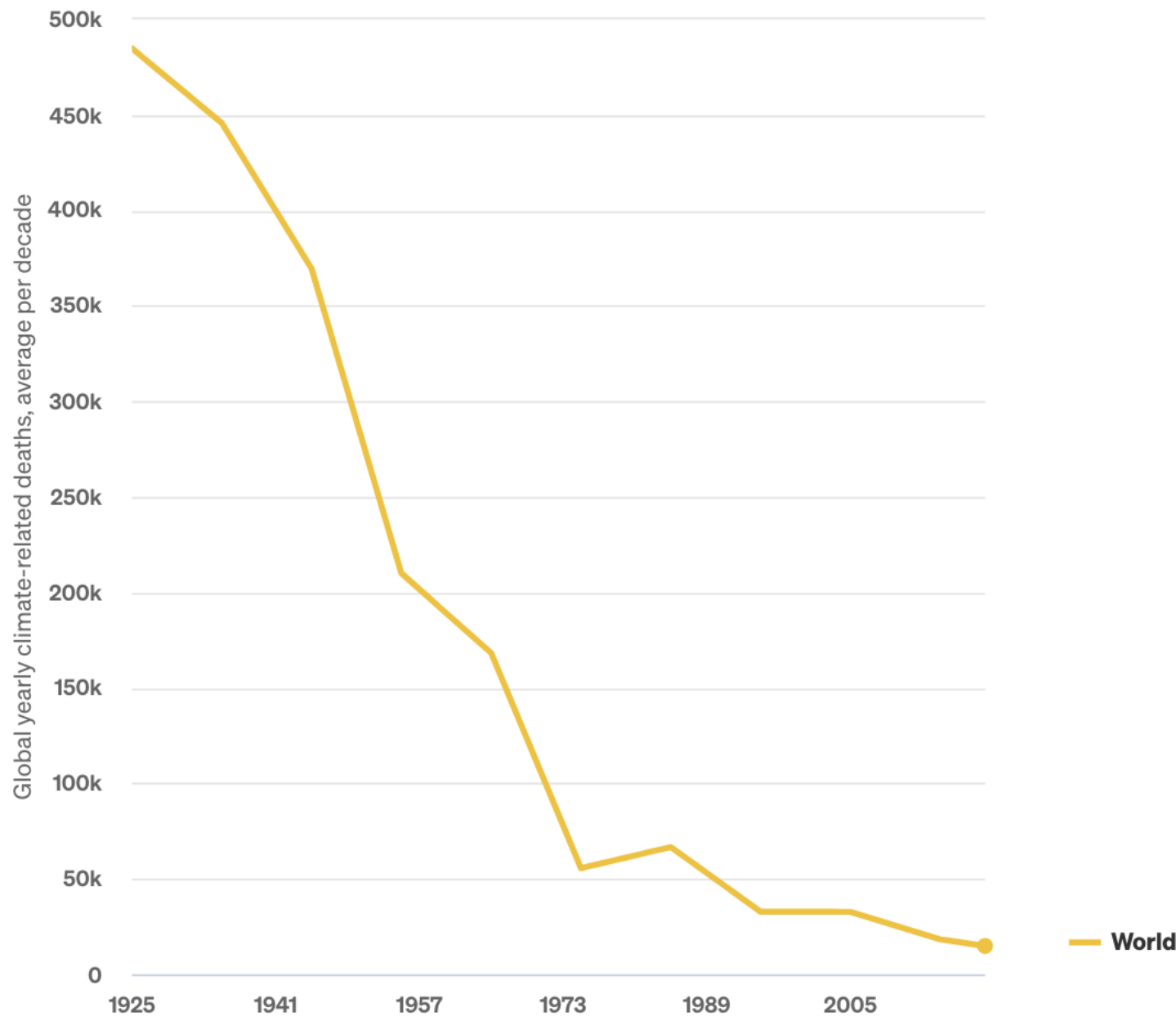
For the time required to earn the money to buy one month of broadband service in 2015, you could get over seven months in 2023.

Over the last century, climate-related deaths—those caused by floods, droughts, storms, wildfires, and extreme temperatures—have fallen by over 96 percent.

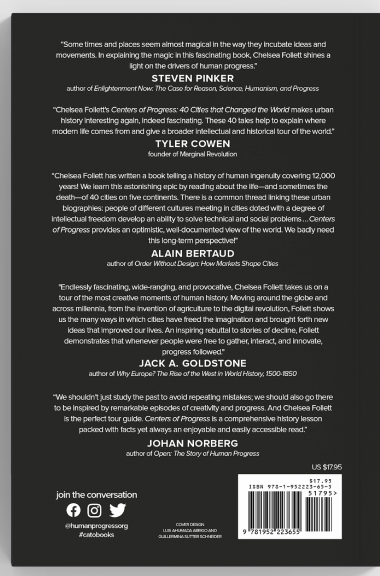
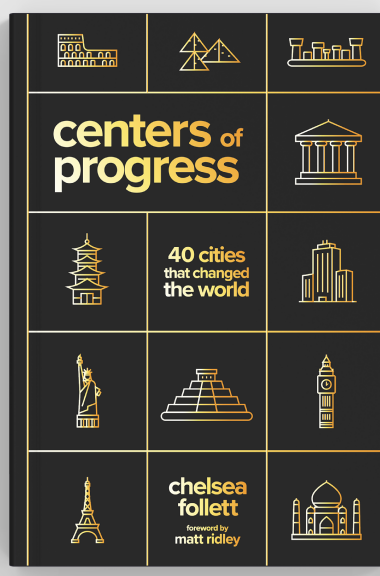
