Every year, media outlets blindly regurgitate their claims.

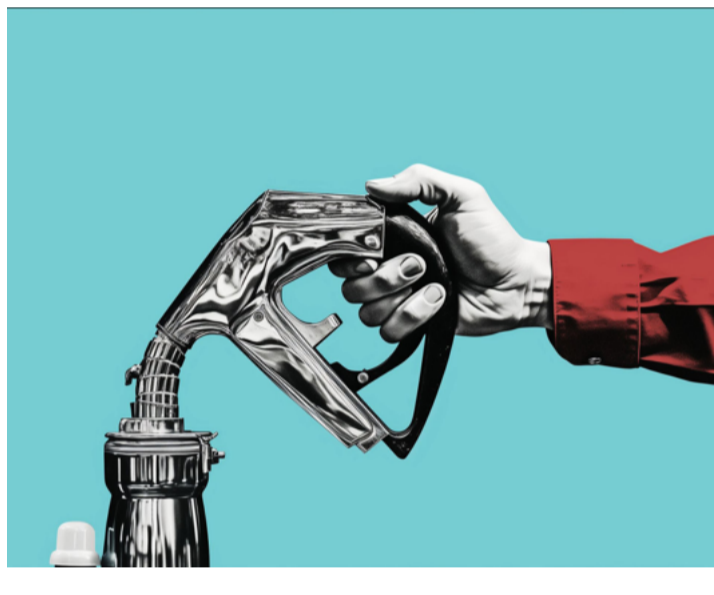
And every year, Oxfam changes its figures and methodology, and always in a way that maximizes PR impact.

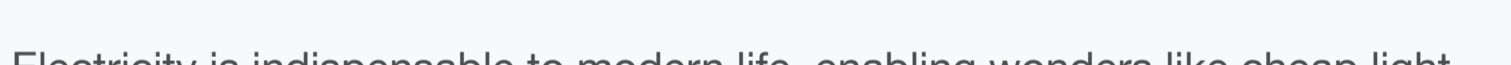
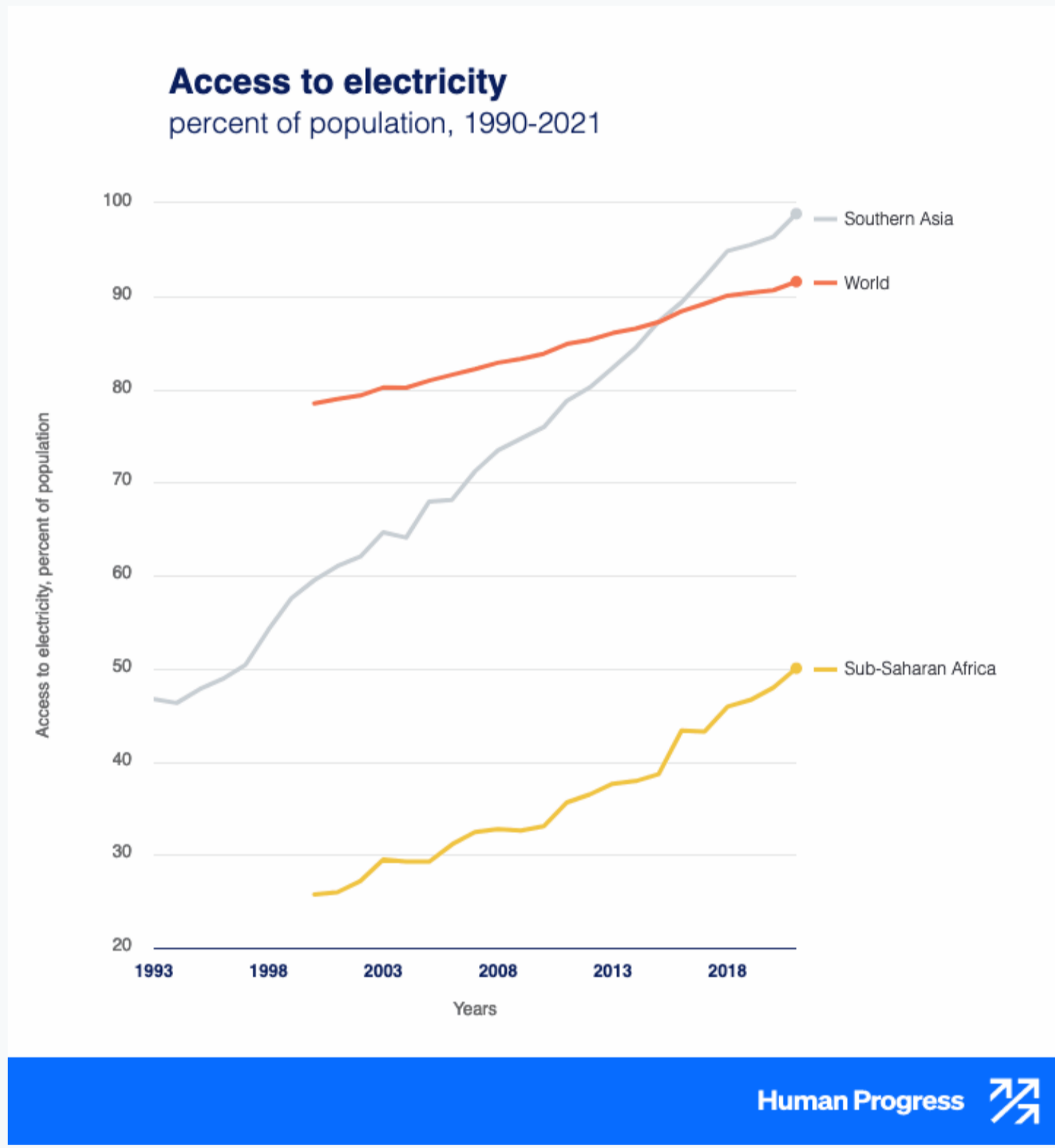

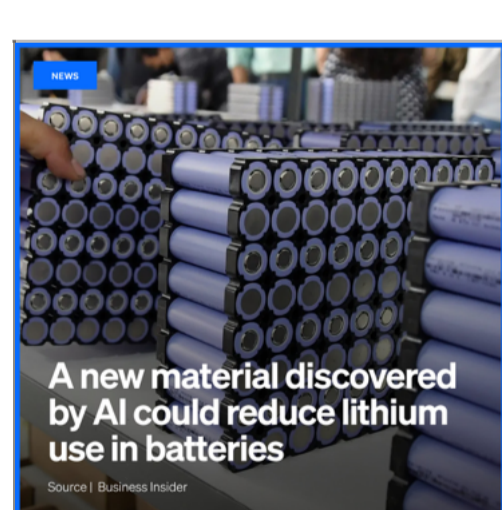
Electricity is indispensable to modern life, enabling wonders like cheap light, indoor climate control, and refrigeration.
