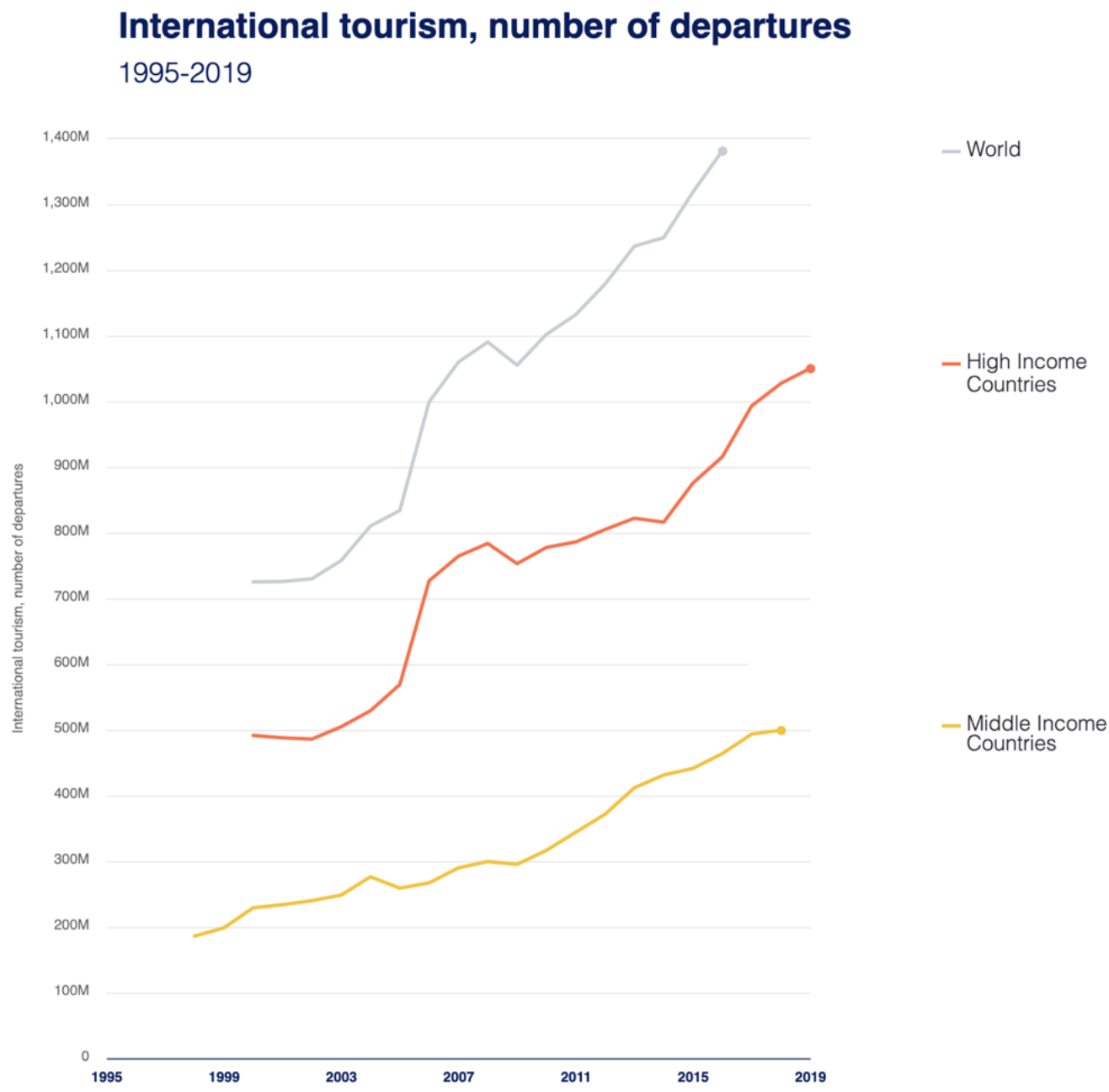

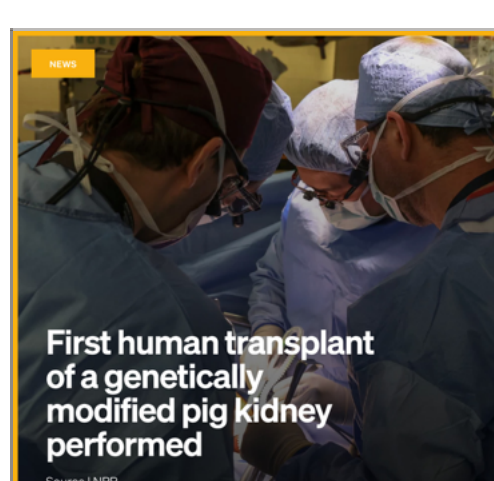
Human Progress

While pandemic restrictions temporarily reversed this trend, over the long term, international travel is becoming accessible to an increasing number of people, [especially in poorer nations](#).

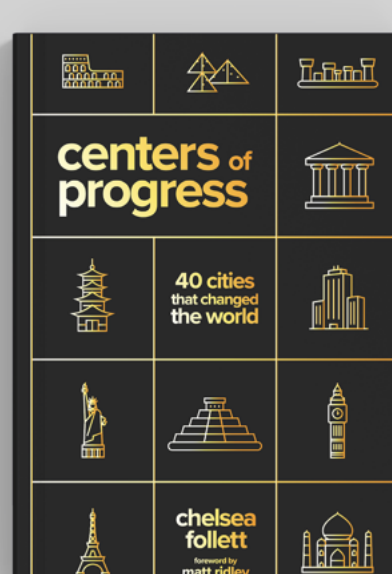
