Digital Representation Drives Progress

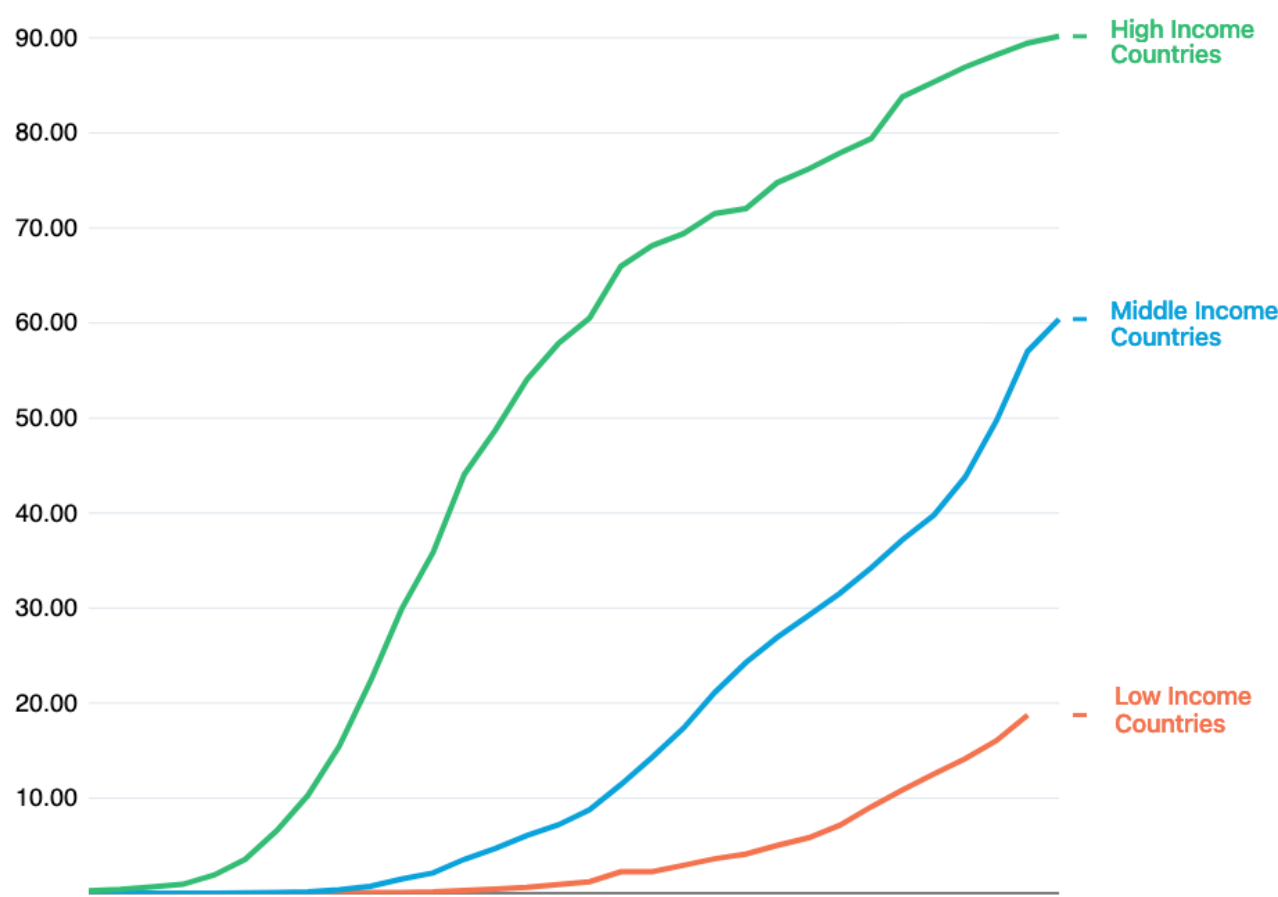
Digitization has enabled vast efficiencies and transformed a range of industries, from entertainment to waste management.

% of population (1990–2022)



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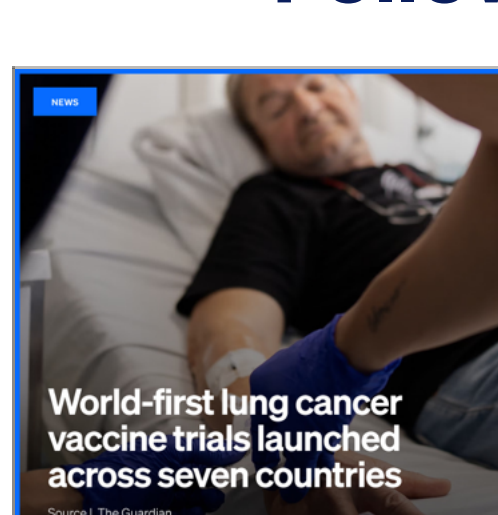
The many benefits of digitization are multiplied by the internet.

As of 2021, 63 percent of the global population used the internet—up from 31 percent just ten years earlier.

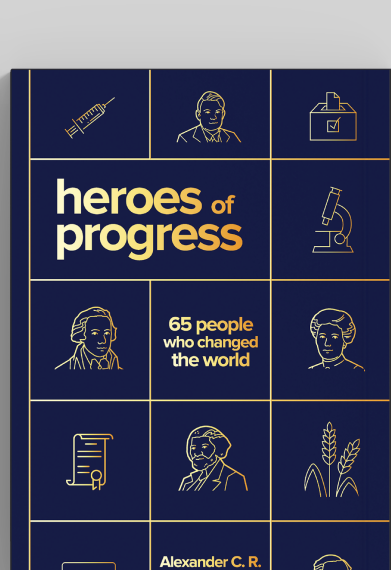
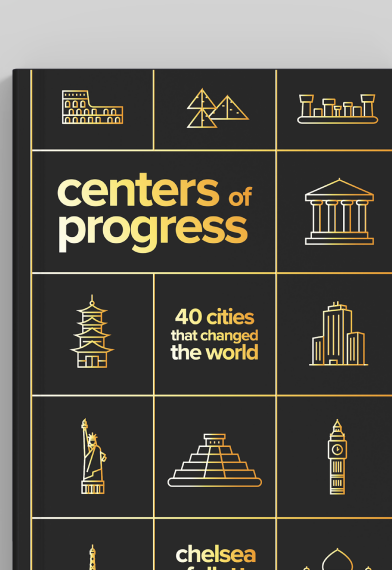
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
